# From Loss to Legacy:

The Journey of Chef Luis & Brother Manuel-The Somni Story



hen I walked into Somni Restaurant in Monroe, NY I immediately felt something different — a quiet warmth that lingers in the air between polished tables and soft lighting, a sense that this place wasn't simply built to serve food, but to share a story. Behind it are two brothers, Chef Luis Naula and Manuel Naula, whose journey from hardship to hospitality embodies perseverance, faith, and the power of a shared dream.

#### A CHILDHOOD MARKED BY LOSS AND RESILIENCE

When I sat down with Chef Luis, he spoke with the humility of someone who has earned every step of his success. "We lost our parents when we were very young," he said softly. "I was 13 and a half, and Manuel was around nine years old. I have 2 younger brothers as well. After my parents passed, everything changed. There was no money, no one to help. I left school at fifteen and came to the United States to find work."He paused, reflecting. "I came here thinking only about my younger brothers — how to help them finish school. Every dollar I saved went to bringing them back here to the U.S., one by one, until we were all together again." That bond — built through loss and determination — became the foundation for everything that would follow.

#### FROM PORTER TO RESTAURATEUR

Brother Manuel began his career humbly, working under his brother's management at STK Restaurant in Manhattan. "I started as a porter," he recalled. "Cleaning floors, restocking, doing anything that needed to be done. But little by little, I moved up — from porter to runner, learning the rhythm of the restaurant world." It was there that he realized he shared in his brother's vision — to one day open a small, family-run bar and restaurant of their own. "We used to talk about it all the time," Luis said with a smile. "We didn't have much, but we had the same dream."

#### A DREAM BUILT TOGETHER

For years, the brothers worked tirelessly — saving, searching, and planning for the right moment. "It took about three years of looking and saving," Manuel told me. "We would work double shifts, then spend our nights scouting spaces or sketching ideas."

By 2018, both had settled in Goshen, NY, seeking not only a shorter commute but a safer, quieter life for their growing families. Chef Luis and his wife, Angelica, a first responder, are raising their six children — Luis, Salma, Chantal, Ariana, Giavana, and Axel — while Manuel is the proud father of Jocelyn and Brandon. His wife Lourdes is also a first responder. Together, the brothers found balance in the community and soon discovered a modest space in nearby Monroe that would become the home of Somni — a name that fittingly means dream in Catalan.

"The rent was high," Luis admitted with a laugh, "but the dream was bigger."

#### THE INFLUENCE OF GREAT MENTORS

Chef Luis credits his growth and philosophy in the kitchen to the remarkable chefs he has had the privilege to work alongside. Among them was Chef Paul Liebrandt, Gavin Citron, and Tod Mark Miller, to name a few. But his greatest influence — and lifelong mentor — was the late Chef David Bouley (May 27, 1953 – February 13, 2024), the celebrated American and French chef best known for his iconic Tribeca restaurant, Bouley.

"Working for Chef Bouley changed my life," Luis shared. "He taught me that the magic behind a great restaurant isn't just in the food — it's in understanding the business, the numbers, and the relationships that make people want to come back again and again."


For over eight years, Luis served as Bouley's purchasing manager, overseeing the ingredients and operations that made the restaurant a legend. "From him, I learned that excellence is in the details — that the business of hospitality is just as important as the art of it."

In a gesture that still moves him deeply, Chef Bouley gifted Luis many of the original tables, chairs, and even kitchen equipment from his restaurant — treasures now lovingly preserved at Somni. "It's a way of keeping my mentor's spirit alive in everything I do," Luis said.

#### **BRINGING SOMNI TO LIFE**

Somni opened quietly, without fanfare — just two brothers, a few loyal friends, and a belief that good food and good energy speak for themselves. Their concept blended Latin and Mediterranean









influences, reflecting both their heritage and their creative curiosity.

"I like to visualize a dish before I cook it," Chef Luis explained. "The colors, the balance. I start with tradition but always add my own touch — something that feels intuitive, something that tells a story." Today, guests come from across the region to experience his signature dishes: the tender duck entrée, the lamb porterhouse cooked on the bone for rich flavor, and other creations that reflect both artistry and soul. "They're all my babies," he laughed. "But the lamb... that one feels special. People taste it and say, 'I've

never had lamb like this.' That means everything to me and to see their smiles."

#### A CHEF ROOTED IN COMMUNITY AND NATURE

When asked what he loves most about living in Goshen, Chef Luis didn't hesitate: "The peace," he said simply. "The tranquility. Those quiet moments give me inspiration — that's when I come up with my recipes." You can often find him at the Goshen Farmers Market, where he shops weekly for seasonal produce and

locally grown fruits that inspire his menu. "Supporting local farmers is important to me," he added. "Each season brings new ingredients and ideas — that's how I keep creating fresh takes on classic dishes."

#### THE HEART OF HOSPITALITY

While Chef Luis commands the kitchen, Manuel brings warmth to the front of the house—crafting cocktails and connections with equal precision. "I love creating drinks that tell their own story," he said, describing his signature smoked old-fashioned made with house-crafted syrups and a touch of theater. "It's simple, but elegant — like the restaurant itself."

Together, the brothers have built something that goes beyond cuisine. Somni is a reflection of family, resilience, and gratitude — a dream realized through discipline and heart.

#### LOOKING AHEAD

When I asked what comes next, both smiled knowingly. "The goal isn't just to grow," Luis said.

"It's to keep building with purpose — to make Somni known not just for great food, but for what it represents: family, hard work, and community." And then, almost as an afterthought, he added with a grin, "Maybe one day, even a Michelin recognition. But for now, we just want to keep improving, one plate at a time."

As I left Somni that evening, the dining room glowed softly behind me — Luis still plating in the kitchen, Manuel greeting guests at the door. Their story, like their restaurant, is proof that dreams built on love and perseverance can become something lasting and beautiful.

Somni isn't just a place to dine — it's a place to live, laugh, and believe.

Isabella Ok Tees Up a Bright Future

For Goshen High School senior **Isabella Ok**, golf began as a family pastime and evolved into a lifelong passion. Introduced to the sport by her father, Chris Ok (pronounced OAK), Isabella and her brother Preston quickly discovered that golf offered much more than competition—it taught patience, focus, and respect for the game and others. Her older brother Harrison, a talented baseball player, proves that athleticism runs deep in the Ok family.

Her father encouraged them to play not only for fun but also for the doors it could open—personally and professionally—down the road. That early guidance has shaped Isabella into one of New York State's top-ranked high school golfers. A four-year varsity player and three-year team captain, she has earned first place at the Section IX Championship, a top-four finish at the NYS Girls Golf Championship, and multiple top placements in MET PGA Future Series tournaments.

Isabella's story is also one of family, culture, and gratitude. Her parents immigrated from South Korea at a young age—her mother growing up in Brooklyn, and her father settling first in **Hawaii** before attending college in **Boston**. Isabella was **born in** New Jersey, and the family moved to Goshen, NY the summer before her kindergarten year. When asked about what she loved most

about her Goshen hometown, she shared "I really like that you know everyone, grew up with everyone, the small local shops, the small-town feel," she says with a smile.

Family remains at the heart of her journey. Each summer, the Oks travel to visit Isabella's grandmother—either in Hawaii or Korea, depending on the weather. After tournaments, Isabella and her dad share a cherished tradition: a bowl of pho and a quiet conversation about the day's play. It's a grounding reminder that success is about more than medals; it's about growth, gratitude, and connection.

Outside of golf, Isabella has always been curious and well-rounded—she once dreamed of becoming an allergist or working in medicine, but her ambitions have shifted toward business. She plans to **play golf** in college while pursuing a business degree, with a possible focus in accounting, though she's open to exploring new paths along the way.

With a **4.0 GPA**, leadership roles in multiple **honor societies**, and a love for mentoring younger players, Isabella continues to inspire those around her. Whether she's teeing off on the green or reminiscing about her childhood hamster, her story is defined by balance, humility, and joy.

## Serving With Heart:

The Junior League's Century of Impact

#### BUILDING COMMUNITY. **EMPOWERING WOMEN. &** INSPIRING A NEW VISION FOR THE FUTURE

For more than a century, the Junior League of Orange County, NY (JLOCNY) has played a vital role in strengthening our community through volunteerism, leadership development, and meaningful local initiatives. Founded in 1922, the League's story is deeply intertwined with the story of Orange County itself-responding to needs as they arise and shaping progress one project at a time.

From supporting food and job programs during the Great Depression to literacy and child-welfare initiatives in more recent decades, the League has remained a steady force for good. "Our work has always evolved with the needs of the people around us," says Ginny Townsend, President of the Board and Goshen resident. "That's what keeps this

organization vibrant after more than 100 years—our members listen, adapt, and take action."

#### A VISION FOR THE FUTURE: THE CHILDREN'S MUSEUM OF ORANGE COUNTY

Today, JLOCNY is channeling its energy into its newest and most ambitious goal vet-the creation of a Children's Museum of Orange County. After completing a months-long feasibility study that gathered hundreds of local survey responses, community interviews, and focus groups, the League is preparing to bring the vision to life.

"This initiative has captured our hearts," Townsend shares. "A children's museum will fill a major gap in our region-giving kids a place to learn, explore, and dream right here in Orange County. It's about more than a building: it's about building experiences that stay with children for life."

The proposed museum will serve as a hub for creativity, play-based learning, and community connection-bringing

together families, educators. and local organizations.

#### A LEAGUE THAT REFLECTS ITS COMMUNITY

For Ginny Townsend, the Junior League's strength lies in its ability to adapt to and represent the places it serves. "Every chapter of the Junior League mirrors its community," she explains. "In Sacramento, where I once served, our focus was nutrition because we were in the heart of California's agricultural region. In the Bay Area, it was girls in STEM. Here in Orange County, the children's museum made perfect sense. It's what our families need most right now."

Townsend's journey with the League spans more than a decade and several states. As the wife of an Air Force officer, she has lived in Omaha, Sacramento. San Francisco, and now the Hudson Valley-joining a new Junior League chapter in each city. "The League became my anchor every time we moved," she says. "It helped me connect with other women, make friends.
